

## **Restricted Bequest**

A common and simple way of supporting nonprofit organizations is by making a provision in your will or trust. The beneficiaries would include your heirs, of course, but many people also name charitable organizations. We appreciate your consideration of Greater Lovell Land Trust in your plans as a beneficiary.
